Senior Project Manager Brian O'Dowd promoted to head department

ANCHORAGE, Alaska – The Alaska Railroad (ARRC) promoted Brian O'Dowd, PE, to Director of Engineering Services, effective July 11. O'Dowd replaces veteran railroad employee Christian Ryll, who retires after nearly 33 years of excellent service.

O'Dowd's experience spans more than a decade of delivering multidisciplinary projects throughout Alaska as a project manager, asset owner, contractor and consultant. His strong background in infrastructure includes construction and maintenance projects for airports, harbors, pipelines, railroads, roadways and vertical buildings. Over the years, he has filled diverse roles, from project and construction management, to strategic and cross-functional team collaboration, to risk assessment and cost estimation, to legal and regulatory consulting.



Brian's considerable record and experience, both at the railroad and with previous employers, made him the clear choice to fill the position, according to ARRC Vice President and Chief Engineer Brian Lindamood. "We recognized Brian's promising career potential early on, when we hired him as an engineering intern in the mid-2000s. He's lived up to that potential, and we're very pleased to see him advance within the railroad."

Following graduation from the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA), O'Dowd expanded his knowledge base by managing and directing projects for key engineering firms, including R & M Consultants and The Hamilton Companies. Returning to the Alaska Railroad as a project manager in 2018, he was promoted to senior project manager in 2021.
