Several activities are geared specifically toward children, such as railroad balloons, tattoos, train safety knick-knacks and walking/talking animal mascots. As the Alaska Railroad's school-business partner, the Government Hill Elementary School's Parent-Teacher Association will be on-hand selling affordable hot dogs, snacks and beverages. The railroad's depot gift shops and rail ticket counters will also be open, and the Alaska Railroad will be offering Open House Specials featuring amazing deals on summer rail travel.
