Alaska's National Parks by Rail

8 Days - Southcentral & Interior Alaska

- › **DAY 1** - Fly into Fairbanks for overnight stay.
- › **DAY 2** - Travel north on a flightseeing tour and marvel at the vast and remote land below. Cross the Arctic Circle and view the rugged Brooks Mountains and the wild expanses of **Gates of the Arctic National Park and Preserve**. Overnight in Fairbanks.
- › **DAY 3** - Take the Denali Star Train south to Denali National Park & Preserve. Watch for views of Denali and keep an eye out for wildlife. Overnight in Denali.
- › **DAY 4** - Travel into **Denali National Park & Preserve** on a narrated tour of the park by bus. Your guide will interpret the history, flora and fauna as you make your way to the heart of the park. Overnight in Denali.
- › **DAY 5** - Spend the morning exploring the area before boarding the Denali Star Train for Talkeetna, home to world-class flightseeing and a charming Main Street. Overnight in Talkeetna.
- › **DAY 6** - Enjoy a morning flightseeing tour for an up-close view of Denali and the Alaska Range. Wander Talkeetna's shops and galleries or visit Denali Brewing Co. for a sampling of Alaska craft beer. Depart on the Denali Star Train to Anchorage. Overnight in Anchorage.
- › **DAY 7** - Take the Coastal Classic Train to Seward. Upon arrival, cruise **Kenai Fjords National Park**. See hanging and tidewater glaciers, and watch for sea otters, sea lions and perhaps even a whale. Evening train departure to Anchorage for overnight stay.
- › **DAY 8** - Watch for Alaska black and brown bears in their natural habitat on a full-day, guided, fly-out Alaska bear-watching trip to **Lake Clark National Park & Preserve**. Your trip concludes in Anchorage.

This unique train – one of the last flagstop trains in America – serves as the sole means of transportation for a stretch of roadless backcountry along the 55-mile expanse between Talkeetna and Hurricane Gulch. Passengers can get off the train anywhere, and hop back on the return journey with the wave of a flag.

M signifies motorcoach transfers from Portage to Anchorage or Girdwood depots. Spencer/Grandview passengers may disembark train at Portage for motorcoach transfers to Anchorage: 5:20 PM - 6:45 PM. Reservations are required.

Glacier Discovery Train will operate round trip from Anchorage to Whittier **only** on the following dates: May 18 & 21, 2016. Daily service will begin May 28, 2016.
