This train operates with the DMU (751) daily. If passenger loads require additional coaches, a locomotive is added to non-DMU end. With the growth of this train in recent years, there are normally always additional cars as well as two baggage cars. This train supports Whistle Stop activities, along with Chugach Adventure Guides, Ascending Path.



# Summer Hurricane Turn

**Route:** Talkeetna/Hurricane Gulch/Talkeetna

**Additional Station Stops:** Numerous unscheduled locations between Gold Creek & Hurricane

This crew is based in Talkeetna. This train is primarily used for locals to access their property along AKRR ROW, and in recent years more and more tourists wanting a local experience or day trip from Talkeetna. Daily mechanical inspections are done with contract labor in Talkeetna and train comes to Anchorage to receive more extensive repairs, as necessary.

**Additional Information:** No guests on train between Anchorage and Whittier in AM and all guests get off in Denali Park NB.

# HAP Northbound Healy Express (NB HEX)

**Operates:** Every Day

**Additional Information:** No guests on train between Denali Park and Healy

Equipment on this train is exclusively Tour Company owned with the exception of locomotive and train crew. This train terminates at Healy NB, where the train is maintained and crew rests.

**Additional Information:** No guests on train between Healy and Denali Park in AM, HAP crew only
