This Addendum is being issued to answer questions and provide clarification.

The Closing Date for this RFQ remains unchanged.

Questions and answers:

1. Q: Is Appendix B the correct Potential Services that would fall under this Term Agreement? The Appendix references “Engineering Services”.

A: This solicitation is one of many term services that are being solicited. The services referenced in Appendix B are generalized and referenced for potential Term services that may be obtained from this or the other term service solicitations being advertised. Although Engineering services are not specifically required by this solicitation, the work in general is an example of required services.
2. Q: Would ARRC select a Contractor that does not include subcontractors that have the capabilities that they do not have (i.e. Wetland Delineations, SWPPP(s), Inspections and Monitoring, Mitigation and/or Restoration Plans)? Can the Offeror propose only for the work they will perform directly and exclude subcontractors for the remaining scope, or is it necessary to demonstrate that the Offeror’s team can cover all aspects in the scope?

A: Offerors are not required to self-perform all services listed in the scope; however, proposals must demonstrate the Offeror’s ability to deliver the full range of services identified in the solicitation—either through in-house capabilities or through identified subcontractors. If an Offeror does not intend to perform certain specialized tasks (e.g., Wetland Delineations, SWPPP development, Inspections, Mitigation Plans), they are expected to identify qualified subcontractors or partners who will fulfill those roles. Proposals need to address how all scope elements will be covered.
3. Q: Regarding the Scope of Work on page 7 in Section 3. Scope of Work, under subsection D, Technical Studies/Environmental Support, it lists transportation/traffic studies. Can you clarify what type of transportation/traffic studies these may be? Would they be related to traffic noise?

A: These types of studies would be for large projects which *may* be under this Term Agreement. Studies would include traffic/transportation capacity and outlooks for future planning as well as traffic/construction noise impact analysis.
